



MEET MA'NEEN

Born October 20, 1990, Ma'neen grew up in a time when the dancehall genre was at its boldest. Maneen is a 90's rude bwoy with an undeniable eloquence, charisma and a fresh style encapsulated by vivid storytelling.

As a teenager, a young Mannin Jerome Ramoon Marsh, now popularly known as Ma'neen, would spend his spare time listening to Motown music and writing original stories and poems. Unbeknownst to him at the time, music would become the way in which he would share his thoughts, perspective and storytelling to a wider audience. Now, as an alternative to his career in technology, Ma'neen is putting his skills to the test. "I don't get to freely express my artistic creativity in my day to day. So, when I write, I create an alter ego for myself that is daring, free and boundless", he said.

Growing up during the 90's, Reggae/ Dancehall had always been described as boogy yaga music (ghetto/not respectable) by the older members of his family. However Ma'neen saw artists who were raising serious concerns regarding our country's development, while at the same time portraying the more fun aspects of our culture.

Ma'neen would find that this genre would intrigue and inspire him to create his own persona in the music game. He started to explore his music talent in church and later got introduced to the business of music as the co-manager of Nanook Enterprises; a legal consultation and space for independent artistes and creatives. "Like any typical Jamaican, I've been around music on the gospel side. I didn't see myself as the best singer at the time. I didn't understand how my voice worked so I focused on my lyricism", Marsh said. Nanook as an environment further helped him to rediscover his love for the music and knew then and there that this path was for him.

The artist enjoys fusing reggae and dancehall sounds with jazz, soul and pop. Sexy Reggae is the name he gives to his eclectic combinations and takes pride in discovering new sounds. He has had the pleasure of working with Gavin Samuels - guitarist from retroactive entertainment and producer prodigy Jean-Andre Lovell Lawrence from JLL Productions who has also been making tremendous strides this year with artists such as Protoje, Govona, Royal Blu, Runkus, Sevana and Lila Ike.






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
